4 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

5 A. My name is Booga K. Gilbertson. My business address is 355 110th Ave. NE,  
6 Bellevue, Washington 98004.

7 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

8 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Senior Vice President of  
9 Operations.

10 **Q. What are your duties as Senior Vice President of Operations?**

11 A. I am responsible for electric and gas operations, including emergency response,  
12 maintenance and construction, electric and gas system operations and dispatch,  
13 and system planning. I also lead project management and engineering across  
14 operations.

15 In addition to my responsibilities at PSE, I serve on the board of directors of the  
16 Western Energy Institute and the EEI National Response Executive Committee. I  
17 also serve on the executive committee of the University of Washington Electrical  
18 Engineering Advisory Board as well as the Washington State University  
19 Electrical Engineering and Computer Science Executive Council.

1 **Q. Briefly describe your relevant employment experience.**

2 A. Since joining PSE in 1985, I have held a broad range of engineering, operations  
3 and management positions in planning, asset management, gas and electric design  
4 engineering, performance measurement, budgeting, project management,  
5 construction and maintenance, 24-hour control center operations, labor relations,  
6 and emergency response management. I have been Vice President of Operations  
7 since 2011.

8 **Q. Briefly describe your education.**

9 A. I hold a Bachelor of Science degree in electrical engineering from the University  
10 of Washington and a Master of Business Administration degree from City  
11 University.
