The Commission's Order 06/03 approved the Settlement Stipulation, which reflected a decrease in annual revenues by \$1.9 million, effective February 1, 2022. Additionally, the Settling Parties agreed to a one-time refund to customer of \$2.8 million that will be amortized over a 12-month period to reflect the lower-than-projected costs for the capital additions included in this proceeding, as well as an adjustment to Washington allocations for specific transmission assets.

Enclosed as Attachment A is the estimated effect of the price changes, including billing determinants and monthly billing comparisons. The average residential customer using 1,200 kWh per month will see a decrease of \$1.59 per month.
