On March 7, 2001, Verizon Northwest Inc. filed tariff advice letters 976 and 977 stating that they are filed in compliance with the Thirteenth Supplemental Order in Docket UT-003013 (Part A). The Commission has requested that staff review the compliance filing and file comments by March 21, 2001.

## Advices 976
