2                   The administrative rules that this petition puts at issue are WAC §§ 480-07-  
340, 480-07-355.

3                   ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric  
customers in the Pacific Northwest. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A.  
Certain members of ICNU purchase power, transmission and distribution services from Puget  
Sound Energy (“PSE” or the “Company”), as indicated on Attachment A. ICNU has been a  
party to many proceedings before the Commission involving PSE, including PSE’s most  
recent general rate case (UE-111048) and its petition for the approval of a power purchase  
agreement for the acquisition of coal transition power (UE-121373).

4                   On February 1, 2013, PSE filed an expedited rate adjustment requesting that  
the Commission issue an order authorizing PSE to increase rates by \$31,901,374 or 1.6% for  
electric customers and decrease rates by \$1,240,267 or 0.1 % for natural gas customers.  
ICNU’s member companies have a substantial interest in PSE’s request, as PSE’s expedited  
rate filing would affect the cost of taking electric service from PSE. ICNU requests leave to  
intervene in this proceeding to represent its members who are affected by the proposed rates.

5                   As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this  
proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected  
by any Commission determination made in connection with this proceeding. It is in the  
public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding. ICNU, therefore, requests that  
the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene and make ICNU a party to this proceeding.

6                   ICNU believes its participation in this proceeding will assist the Commission.  
Furthermore, ICNU’s intervention in this proceeding will not unreasonably broaden the  
issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

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WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully petitions the Commission for leave to intervene in this proceeding.
