
Dear Mr. Johnson:

Pursuant to the settlement agreement of the parties incorporated in the Commission's Order referenced above, and specifically to Section 8, Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc. ("Peninsula") agreed to file a general rate case with Commission by July 1, 2020. Due to the ongoing Covid 19 pandemic and the dislocations caused thereby, Peninsula respectfully requests an extension of time to file its general rate case until at least September 1, 2020. While currently due to records' inaccessibility and dislocations of parties, it is not certain that it can file by that date. Peninsula in the abundance of caution would at least request a 60-day extension in order to comply with the Commission's requirement that it file a general rate case.
