The Commission, January 16, 1990, entered its Fourth Supplemental Order in this docket directing Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a U S WEST Communications (USWC) to refile certain tariff revisions complying with terms of the order as it related to annual switched access charge reductions.

On March 1, 1990, the Commission received a tariff filing from USWC, designated for reference as Docket No. 900192.

FINDINGS

The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed by USWC, March 1, 1990, are in accordance with the intent of the Commission's Fourth Supplemental Order in Docket No. U-89-2698-F and U-89-3245-P as it related to annual reductions in USWC's switched access charges and that the tariff revisions should become effective as filed.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS That the tariff revisions filed herein by USWC, March 1, 1990, and with an inserted effective date of April 2, 1990, which are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein, shall become effective as filed, and that the rates, charges and conditions therein are hereby specified as the rates, charges and conditions to be applicable to service on and after April 2, 1990.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That jurisdiction is retained by the Commission to effectuate the provisions of this and prior orders entered in this docket.
