Reasons supporting proposal: The Commission adopted an extensive revision of WAC 480-30 in 2006. In 2013, the Commission adopted amendments to update regulations governing the criteria and process for granting applications for certificates, and to allow flexibility in rate setting. The 2013 amendments were intended to address changes in the transportation market. Since that time the transportation options available to individuals traveling to and from airports and other destinations have increased beyond even what was available in 2013. The Commission believes the proposed rules will give certificated passenger transportation companies additional flexibility to compete in the marketplace without jeopardizing passenger safety or consumer protection.
