**REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF FULLY NEGOTIATED AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION

In accordance with WAC 480-07-640, Company A requests approval of the fully negotiated amendment to an interconnection agreement, as described below:

Amendment No.5 is a letter agreement to memorialize a process for decommissioning a limited number of collocation sites that Qwest records indicate may have equipment connected to customer circuits. The Parties disagree about the process for decommissioning such collocation spaces. Therefore, in order to avoid a prolonged dispute about whether the parties' ICAs permit Qwest to deny MCImetro's requests to decommission these sites, the parties have entered into a letter agreement setting forth the process and risk allocation for decommissioning the collocation sites in question.

This amendment amends the interconnection agreement first approved by the Commission on October 11, 2006 in WUTC Docket No. UT-063055 (current docket number) between Qwest Corporation and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC dba Verizon Access Transmission Services

Company A represents that the amendment does not discriminate against non-party carriers, that it is consistent with state and federal law, and that it is in the public interest. By virtue of Company B's signature on the amendment, Company A believes that Company B agrees with these representations.

The Commissioners, having reviewed the information available in this matter and having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
