6 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

7 A. My name is Troy A. Hutson, and my business address is 355 110th Avenue NE,
8 Bellevue, Washington 98004. I am the Director, Energy Equity for Puget Sound
9 Energy (“PSE”).

10 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

11 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Director, Energy Equity.

12 **Q. What are your duties as Director, Energy Equity of PSE?**

13 A. As the Director, I am responsible for leading and managing PSE efforts to fulfill
14 energy equity regulatory commitments, operationalization of energy equity across
15 PSE operations, and development and implementation of PSE’s strategy to lead
16 the company on our journey towards energy equity.

17 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

18 A. I have a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from Seattle University, a Doctor
19 of Law (JD) from University of Washington, and hold a law license in
20 Washington state.

1 I am currently a member on the Seattle Children’s Health System and Seattle
2 Children’s Hospital Board of Trustees. I chair the Quality and Medical Staff
3 Oversight committee, and serve on the Executive and Research committees. I am
4 also a member of the board level Health Equity and Anti-Racism taskforce
5 created to prioritize equity by advocating for and facilitating the work toward the
6 recognition and elimination of health inequities for children, families and
7 communities, through an inclusive and anti-racist framework.

8 From 2008 to 2011, I was Assistant Secretary for the Economic Services
9 Administration at the Washington State Department of Social & Health Services
10 (DSHS) where I led strategic efforts to positively transform the client experience
11 while managing increased caseloads and a reduced operating budget.

12 I have worked at PSE for 12 years providing strategic and operational leadership
13 across a number of enterprise functions focused on improving the customer
14 experience and operational efficiency, as well as oversight and coordination of
15 strategic project portfolio, organizational change management and process
16 improvement. Most recently I led corporate compliance, privacy, operational
17 training and quality management. Near the end of 2022, I assumed my current
18 role of Director of Energy Equity.
