Dear Mr. King:

On January 6, 2015, Public Counsel, Commission Staff, and Puget Sound Energy (PSE) (Joint Parties) notified the Commission that as a result of the formal collaborative process conducted in the above-captioned dockets, they have reached an agreement on proposed changes to PSE's Power Cost Adjustment. Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) does not plan to join the settlement. The Joint Parties planned to file a settlement agreement and supporting testimony by January 30, 2015.

Subsequently, Staff counsel experienced a death in her immediate family and was absent from the office for a period of time in January. Staff has requested that the date for filing settlement materials be extended until February 27, 2015. Public Counsel and PSE support the request. Accordingly, the Joint Parties respectfully request that the date for filing settlement materials be postponed until February 27, 2015.
