COMES NOW Qwest Corporation (“Qwest”) and submits the following final list of issues pursuant to Order No. 1 and Order No. 4, after consultation with all parties. Because the CLECs did not agree with the original format of the issues list, a matrix showing the issues proposed by the parties and the parties’ stated positions on the issues is Attachment 1 to this pleading. In addition to the issues and the parties’ stated positions on the issues, which the CLECs requested be added to this matrix, there also appears an indication of whether the issue is contested, whether Qwest desires a hearing on the issue and a column for disputed issues of fact. The latter two items were added at the request of MCI, and by providing a preliminary list of disputed issues of fact in this matrix, Qwest does not concede that whether

such issues exist or not is the proper test to determine Qwest's motion for a hearing in this case, or that the addition of such matters is necessary or appropriate for this list.<sup>1</sup>

Pursuant to the suggestion of the ALJ and the agreement of the parties, Qwest served as scrivener of this list and except as to Issues 1 through 5 and 7, Qwest takes no responsibility for the wording of the issue or with respect to whether the issue is properly before the Commission in this six month review, and Qwest reserves the right to contest the consideration of any such other issues in this proceeding. Qwest specifically objects to consideration of issues 6, 8 and 9 on the attachment as being beyond the scope of issues set forth in Section 16.1 of the QPAP for consideration in any six month review.
