Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade) and MDU Resources Group, Inc. (MDU Resources) have asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for authorization to transfer ownership and operation of Cascade to MDU Resources. This transfer is contingent upon approval by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.

MDU Resources, through its utility divisions Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. and Great Plains Natural Gas Co., and through its subsidiary business units, is engaged in several lines of business that focus on the energy and natural resources industries. MDU Resources has over 80 years of utility experience, and currently serves approximately 250,000 natural gas utility customers and 118,000 electric utility customers. MDU Resources will operate Cascade as a separate subsidiary, and will retain the existing name.
