RE: *WUTC v. Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc.*, Docket TG-190476

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On December 10, 2019, the Commission issued Order 01 in Docket TG-190476. Order 01 approved, without condition, the Settlement Agreement and accompanying Joint Narrative as filed by Commission staff and Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc. (“Company”) on December 3, 2019. Among the conditions placed on the Company by the Settlement Agreement is the requirement that the Company file a general rate case (“GRC”) with the Commission by July 1, 2020.

On April 6, 2020, counsel for the Company filed a letter with the Commission seeking an extension of time to file its GRC “until at least September 1, 2020” due to ongoing complications related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Staff does not object to granting the Company a defined 60-day extension in order to comply with the Commission’s requirement that it file a GRC. Staff’s only request is that the Commission set a date-certain (*i.e.*, September 1, 2020) by which the Company must file its GRC.¹

¹ The Company’s April 6, 2020 letter indicates that it seeks an extension “until *at least* September 1, 2020” and that it “would *at least* request a 60-day extension” to file its GRC. (Emphasis added.) Staff’s non-objection to the Company’s April 6, 2020 request is conditioned on a defined 60-day extension period that would require the Company to file its GRC with the Commission by September 1, 2020.
