The Commission, February 14, 1990, entered its Fifth Supplemental Order in this docket directing Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a U S WEST Communications (USWC) to refile certain tariff revisions complying with terms of the order as it related to \$8.14 million in temporary rate reductions. Upon appeal, Superior Court for King County affirmed the order in part and reversed in part and remanded the matter to the Commission for re-evaluation of the amount of the reduction.

On May 1, 1990, the Commission received a tariff filing from USWC, designated for reference as Docket No. UT-900419. The effect of this filing would be to implement temporary reduction totalling \$7,978,000.

FINDINGS

The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed by USWC, May 1, 1990, are in accordance with the intent of the Commission's Fifth Supplemental Order in Docket No. U-89-2698-F as it related to temporary reductions in USWC's tariffed rates and that the tariff revisions should become effective as filed.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS That the tariff revisions filed herein by USWC, May 1, 1990, and with an inserted effective date of June 2, 1990, which are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein, shall become effective as filed, and that the rates, charges and conditions therein are hereby specified as the rates, charges and conditions to be applicable to service on and after June 2, 1990.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That jurisdiction is retained by the Commission to effectuate the provisions of this and prior orders entered in this docket.
