TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 19, 2020, Puget Sound Pilots (PSP) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) its initial proposed tariff. On November 21, 2019, the Commission entered Order 01, suspending the tariff filing and setting the matter for adjudication.

On March 31, 2020, the Commission entered Order 04, Granting Motion to Extend Suspension Date; Modifying Procedural Schedule, which set an evidentiary hearing for August 12-13, 2020, in the Commission's hearing room.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and the Governor's proclamations requiring social distancing, Commission will hold a virtual evidentiary hearing.
