RESPONSE:

Please note that per Table 16 page 3 of Attachment E in the Company's response to WUTC Request No. 171, the signing bonuses for Mr. Matthews, Mr. Meyer and Mr. Turner pro formed in the test period are \$74,913 and \$18,761 for Washington Electric and Gas jurisdictions, respectively.

Signing bonuses are prevalent among executive and professional employees. These awards serve as an additional incentive to the recruit, drawing the executive to the new organization. Stock-based signing bonuses serve additional purposes - they provide the new hire with an immediate carried interest in the company, closely aligning the executive's financial wellbeing with the company's and, as they generally vest over a multi-year period, act as a retention incentive.
