Dear Judge Caille,

I request that you schedule a brief conference call with counsel during the next three days to discuss scheduling additional hearing days.

I do not believe that adequate hearing days have been scheduled to permit Stericycle to properly cross-examine Sure-Way's witnesses or to present Stericycle's own case. I request that additional hearing days be scheduled during the last two weeks of September, if possible.

The hearing days scheduled from August 30 to Sept. 1 will be needed for Sure-Way's operational witnesses. Although I suspect that too many days have been scheduled for shipper/generator witnesses, Mr. Haffner indicates that at this point he wishes to retain the six days of hearing currently scheduled in Spokane (Sept. 7-9) and Tri-Cities (Sept. 14-16). This leaves no hearing days for the presentation of Stericycle's witnesses. Stericycle should be able to present its case following the conclusion of Sure-Way's case.

Greg Haffner, counsel for Sure-Way, leaves on vacation after Thursday this week and will be unavailable during the following week.

I have spoken with Mr. Haffner and Greg Trautman, AAG. Mr. Haffner has no objection to the scheduling of additional hearing days during the last two weeks of September.

All counsel are available for a conference call on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday this week as follows:

Tuesday, August 2: 9-12 and 2-5 Wednesday, August 3: 9-12, 2-5

Thursday, August 4: 8-9
