By the 2023 Biennial CEIP Update, PSE will designate a minimum percentage of energy benefits that will flow to Named Communities with deepest need."⁵

PSE will also modify its program design for solar and storage DER programs to better ensure benefits flow to Named Communities, including by developing targeting for Named Communities beyond using income as the sole criterion for program eligibility; offering higher incentives for low-income customers and Named Communities; ensuring benefits flow to tenants in affordable multifamily housing; and targeting storage programs to Vulnerable Populations where increased reliability would reduce vulnerabilities."⁶

PSE will collaborate with the EAG, other relevant advisory groups, and interested persons to develop this pilot.
