Discussion:

This meeting is being set up as per the discussion that took place at the "Ground Faults and Gas Pipe" that took place on June 20. At that meeting, it was agreed that we're try to meet periodically to build our collective knowledge of ground faults and how they can affect natural gas systems.

The primary focus of this meeting will be PSE's pilot program. Those on the call will recall that PSE is running a pilot program under which certain electrical events will be reported to Gas Operations. Depending on the location of gas piping relative to the location of the electric event (generally, if piping is within 600'), a Gas First Responded will investigate the site and determine if follow up actions (such as a special leak survey) are necessary. The pilot runs from May 19 – July 31.
