Further on follow-up from our meet and confer, Staff will be able to supplement DR 44 (and also, almost by definition, DR 11) by Friday, October 21.

This will certainly include some re-production of records you already have. Prior counsel did not bates stamp their productions, making it difficult for us to know what productions were made in response to which data requests. For that reason, we are erring on the side caution, even if that means some duplicative production.

The production on Friday, October 21, will include over 1,000 documents and emails, but, as I say above, we believe you already have most of these but cannot verify from our end they were provided in response to DRs 11 or 44.

   8-11 timeframe. We will get back to you with a specific date soon.

It was a pleasure to meet you yesterday. Following up on our meet and confer I promised you three things:

- 1. A supplementation of Staff's response to CLC DR 28
- 2. An explanation regarding redacted and withheld materials responsive to CLC DRs 33 and 44
- 3. A choice from Staff regarding whether to supplement CLC DRs 37-42 or consent to the deposition of Mr. Webber

### Supplement to DR 28

This will be distributed to all parties by the end of the day tomorrow (October 7, 2022).

### Redacted and Withheld Material Responsive to DRs 33 and 44

Contrary to your assertions during the meet and confer yesterday, communications between experts and attorneys that do not contain factual matter upon which the expert bases their opinion but that do contain mental impressions, legal theories, and other attorney work product are privileged from discovery under the work product privilege. *Dempsey v. Spokane Washington Hosp. Co.*, LLC, 1 Wn.

App. 2d 628 (2017). It is for this reason that you see redactions in certain communications between Staff's counsel and Staff's expert witnesses and that certain materials responsive to DRs 33 and 44 were withheld.

Regardless, we will supplement our response to DRs 33 and 44 with redacted versions of such correspondence where appropriate and/or note on a privilege log where such correspondence has been withheld. For DR 33 respective to Dr. Akl, that will be completed by the close of business tomorrow, Friday October 7.

We do not have a timeline for Mr. Webber's correspondence at the moment, but will either provide a timeline or supplement our response by Friday, October 14.

I understand that for prior productions, you have given staff directions for a secure file transfer site. The Attorney General's Office generally provides an SFT site for these purposes, but if you would prefer to use your site that's fine. Please send directions for the best means of production to Rebecca Davila-Simmons, CC'd on this email.

## Deposition of Mr. Webber

Staff will stand on their objections to DRs 37-42. Whether you wish to note a deposition of Mr. Webber is your choice and perogative. I will note, however, that Mr. Webber is not available until November 8-11. Staff will agree to a continuance of the discovery cut-off solely for the purpose of deposing Mr. Webber.
