Qwest Corporation's Reply to Motions for Summary Determination

Dear Ms. Washburn:

In Paragraph 10 of Order No. 2 in this consolidated docket, the Administrative Law Judge set a briefing schedule whereby parties would file motions for summary determination on December 5, 2003 and replies on December 23, 2003. Qwest, AT&T, Commission Staff, Public Counsel and Comcast filed motions for summary determination. Time Warner filed a letter indicating support for Comcast's position. As Qwest's December 5 motion addresses each legal issue relevant to this case, Qwest will not burden the record by filing a reply brief repeating the same points.

Qwest will note, however, that a good portion of the motions of AT&T and Comcast are dedicated to policy arguments that could have properly been made by those parties during the lengthy rulemaking proceeding that ultimately resulted in the adoption of WAC 480-120-439. Those policy arguments, some of which were addressed by other carriers during the rulemaking, simply do not override the clear language of WAC 480-120-021 and -439, which, read together, unambiguously impose service quality reporting requirements on Comcast and other sizeable CLECs in Washington.
