Dear Ms. Davis:

On May 5, 2008, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed a joint request for approval of Amendment #7 to the Interconnection Agreement (agreement) between Qwest and Time Warner Telecom of Washington LLC (Time Warner) in Docket UT-043083. The agreement is a delegated item scheduled for approval by July 29, 2008.

The agreement is three days late. The commission reserves the right to investigate, and if appropriate, commence a separate proceeding to complain and enforce against, and penalize, Time Warner and/or Qwest for failure to meet the filing requirements of Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. WAC 480-07-640 (effective January 1, 2004) requires interconnection agreements be filed for approval within 30 days after the agreement is signed. A similar letter has been sent to Qwest.
