BILATERAL COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT ALDER LAKE COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEM AND WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

The following compliance agreement is hereby established between the Washington State Department of Health (hereafter, Department) and the purveyor of the Alder Lake Community Water System, ID #26995H, a Group A-community water system in Pierce County (hereafter, Alder Lake).

The purpose of this compliance agreement is to formalize a schedule to support compliance with Chapter 246-290 WAC.

Background Information

It was determined that the two groundwater sources S01 and S02 that serve the Alder Lake Community water system are in 'hydraulic connection' with Alder Lake (DOH letter dated December 19, 2000). As such, the wells must be disinfected to achieve a minimum CT of 6 in accordance with WAC 246-290-451. While the proposed disinfection system for Alder Lake has been approved by DOH on January 31, 2002 the system has not been installed as the purveyor has been arranging financing for the upgrade.

The Alder Lake Community water system agrees to:

 Install facilities. By January 31, 2004, install facilities in accordance with approved construction documents and submit a construction completion report for the new facilities as per WAC 246-290-120.

The Department agrees to:

- Defer enforcement. DOH shall not initiate any enforcement actions for violation of WAC 246-290-451 as long as the conditions of this agreement are being met. DOH also agrees to intercede on the behalf of the purveyor with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for violations covered by this agreement as long as its conditions are being met.
- Renegotiate agreement. DOH will renegotiate the level of activity or schedules in this agreement if
 requested by Alder Lake. Any schedules required by this agreement will be automatically
 incorporated into it.
