On December 14, 2006, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities and the Public Counsel Section of the Attorney General's Office (collectively, "the Moving Parties") requested a two month extension for each phase of the procedural schedule in this case. Granting their request would move the pre-filing of response testimony from January 12, 2007 to March 12, 2007. Evidentiary hearings would move from February 12-15, 2007 to April 11-13, 2007.
