- Subsection (7) – Establish timelines only for up to 50 or 300 poles
- Subsection (9) – Limit work of contractors to communications space

#### C. 480-54-050 Modification costs; notice; temporary stay

- Subsection (3) – Proportionate sharing of modification costs
- New subsection to address abandoned attachments

#### D. 480-54-060 Rates

- Subsection (2) – FCC cable rate v. FCC pre-2011 telecom rate

#### E. 480-54-070 Complaint

- Subsection (4) – Ability to challenge provisions of signed agreement
- Subsection (5) – Access to information required to calculate rates
- Subsection (7) – Limitation on remedial refund/payment period
