TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On November 8, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity to File Written Comments in Docket UE-210804 soliciting feedback from interested parties on Commission staff's (Staff) investigation to determine whether additional guidance related to the cost-effectiveness of distributed energy resources (DERs) is necessary. Staff intends to develop a jurisdiction-specific test for DERs that incorporates the goals of the Clean Energy Transformation Act. Staff's investigation will follow the process and principles described in the [National Standard Practice Manual For Benefit-Cost Analysis of Distributed Energy Resources](#). The Commission has held three virtual workshops, on May 10, August 1, and September 20, 2022, addressing interested parties' feedback and discussing applicable policy goals, current practice, utility system impacts, and non-utility system impacts.

The Commission will convene a two-hour virtual workshop on Wednesday, November 9, 2022, at 10 a.m. to present Commission Staff's straw proposal for initial discussion.
