## SCHEDULE 21 FIRM SALES SERVICE HIGH LOAD FACTOR

### AVAILABLE:

In all territory served by the Company under the Tariff of which this schedule is a part. To Non-Residential Customers, up to a specified MDDV, in all territory served by the Company under the Tariff of which this schedule is a part. No seasonal or temporary Discontinuance of Service is permitted. The Company may require that Customer provide active and continuous telephone and electric service to the meter(s) at Customer's Premise, subject to charges set forth in **SCHEDULE C**. Transportation Service is subject to **SCHEDULE T**.

### APPLICABLE:

To firm sales service to **commercial, institutional or industrial** establishments, for use in approved equipment and installations. Customers with an **MDDV** greater than 500 therms shall execute a written service agreement with the Company, specifying the **MDDV, MHDV**, and pressures of the equipment to be served. Company reserves the right to regulate the flow of so as to limit the hourly rate of flow to not more than seven (7) percent of the customer's **MDDV**. See **SCHEDULE 21-T** for related transportation service.

### SERVICE DESCRIPTION:

Service under this schedule is Firm Service to approved equipment and installations, under a written service agreement for a term of not less than one year. Company reserves the right to regulate the hourly flow of gas to not more than seven percent (7%) of Customer's MDDV. Gas taken in excess of Customer's MDDV shall be unauthorized, subject to charges set forth in **SCHEDULE C**.

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Except for the first peak period, if initial deliveries occur later than May 15, the Peak Period Surcharge will apply to all Therms used during October through May April (peak period) in excess of the average used in the four (4) highest billing months of the preceding May through October September (base period). Customer must notify Company of any expected peak period usage increases in writing prior to the expected increase, and Company may re-calculate Customer's monthly billings for the remainder of that peak period based upon the base use in the succeeding base period.

The Base Distribution Rate includes amounts shown in **SCHEDULES 203 AND 207**. The Temporary Adjustment stated above represents the sum of amounts shown in **SCHEDULES 201, 205 AND 208. AND 213**. The Billing Rate is subject to additional adjustment, as set forth in **SCHEDULE A** of this Tariff.

### SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

1. ~~For purposes of this schedule, the peak period is the period October through May. The base period is the period May through October. The peak period surcharge shall be added for gas used during the peak period in excess of the average used in the four highest billing months during the preceding base period. The surcharge shall not apply to the first peak period where initial deliveries occur later than May 15.~~
2. ~~Customer must notify Company in writing prior to any expected increase in usage during the peak period. Upon notification, Company shall make a re-determination of monthly billings rendered for the remainder of such peak period based upon the base use in the succeeding base period, and will adjust customer's account accordingly.~~

### GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Service under this schedule is subject to the General Rules and Regulations contained in this Tariff and to those prescribed by regulatory authorities, as amended from time to time.
