This email is being sent to parties that have submitted comments in Docket U-090222 to inform parties of the Commission's intention to make a non-substantive change to the wording in the proposed CR-102 rules at WAC 480-100-505(2)(a)(vi).

The proposed rule as submitted to the code reviser on December 22, 2009 at WAC 480-100-505(2)(a)(vi) reads:

(vi) The ability to deliver two-way communication of real time prices or other contract terms and to enable customer demand response programs.
