On December 14, 2017, Avista submitted proposed revisions to its tariff Schedule 77 in the above referenced docket. In that filing the Company incorrectly listed the effective date on the proposed tariff sheets as February 1, 2017. The correct requested effective date as described in the cover letter with that filing should have been February 1, 2018. In addition, the Company submitted a redlined version of the proposed tariff sheets as a courtesy to Staff and others, to help easily identify the changes made to the tariff sheets.
