Dear Mr. Johnson:

Commission Staff (Staff) reviewed the compliance filings of Shuttle Express, Inc. (Shuttle Express or Company) dated August 31, 2018, in response to Order 20 (Final Order) issued November 17, 2017, and Order 22 (Payment Arrangement) issued December 8, 2017, in Docket TC-143691, and accommodating the Settlement Agreement and Release of Claim (Settlement Agreement) signed by the Commission April 30, 2018, which revised the approved payment plan outlined in Order 22.

The Company was ordered to pay \$120,000 within 90 days of the effective date of the Final Order, which was revised in the Payment Arrangement to a payment plan with a final payment due no later than September 15, 2018. The Settlement Agreement suspended \$50,000 of the penalty, and revised the amounts of the payment plan accordingly, with the final payment still due no later than September 15, 2018.

On August 31, 2018, Shuttle Express submitted its final payment in accordance with Orders 20 and 22, and the approved Settlement Agreement.

Staff has reviewed all of the Company's payments and believes that the submittals fully comply with the Commission's Order 20, entered November 17, 2017, Order 22, entered December 8, 2017, and the Settlement Agreement approved April 30, 2018.

Staff previously reported the Company's compliance with the Final Order on January 4, 2018, and March 21, 2018, which was acknowledged by the Commission on March 28, 2018, which together with payment of the penalty completes the Company's compliance items ordered in consolidated Dockets TC-143691, TC-160516 and TC-161257. Therefore Staff recommends that all parties be notified of the Company's compliance and these dockets be closed.
