MEMORANDUM

- 1 The Commission entered Order No. 05 Approving and Adopting Settlement Agreement with Conditions on December 21, 2005. The Order states in part at ¶177 that Avista is required to rerun the AURORA power cost model to incorporate certain adjustments prior to making its compliance filing. The Order sets December 27, 2005, as the date for compliance.

- 2 On December 22, 2005, Avista filed a motion requesting a two day extension so that it can complete the process and make the necessary revisions to its tariff sheets. Avista’s motion states that the Company has discussed this matter with Commission Staff and Staff has agreed that if Avista meets a 10:00 a.m. filing deadline on December 29, 2005, this will provide an adequate opportunity for review of Avista’s compliance filing and will allow for an effective date of January 1, 2006, as provided in Order No. 05.

ORDER

- 3 The Commission, finding good cause, grants Avista's motion and revises the schedule for the Company's compliance filing as discussed in the body of this Order.
