NOTICE OF HEARING ON MOTION TO COMPEL (Set for October 26, 2022, at 10:30 a.m.)

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. CenturyLink Communications, Docket UT-181051

TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 22, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), on its own motion, and through its staff (Staff) issued a complaint against CenturyLink Communications, LLC, (CenturyLink or Company) in Docket UT-181051 regarding interruptions in 911 service on December 27, 2018.

On October 14, 2022, Century Link filed a Motion to Compel Staff to respond in full to Data Requests 28, 31, 32, 34(c-d), 35 and 37–42 pursuant to Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-07-425(1)(b).¹

On October 21, 2022, Staff filed a Response opposing the Motion to Compel.

Under WAC 480-07-425(1)(b), a presiding officer will hear a Motion to Compel at the earliest reasonable time. Accordingly, the Commission hereby gives notice that it will convene a virtual hearing on the Motion to Compel on Wednesday, October 26, 2022, at 10:30 a.m.
