Attached for filing with the Commission is an electronic copy of Avista Corporation's, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or "the Company"), "Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Project Report". The Company initially filed this document and its associated Appendix A on August 28, 2020, with a replacement filing on August 31, 2020. Since that time, Avista has discovered an inadvertent error overstating the amount of savings achieved for manual meter reading in 2018. In this update, the financial benefits (on a nominal and net present value basis) have been adjusted accordingly, in addition to making several non-substantive grammatical edits.
