Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or Company), submits its "revised" Schedule 62 tariff sheets in the above referenced Docket No. The Company, Commission staff and other stakeholders have been able to resolve the few remaining issues. The Company also requests, and Commission Staff supports that the Commission allow a one-time wavier of WAC 480-106-040(1)(b)(i) that would allow the Company to calculate capacity contribution values for various fuel types based on its 2019 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP).
