Dear Mr. Curl:

We are addressing you as the representative of the Washington Utilities & transportation Commission. We are most adamantly opposed to WAC 480-120-141(9).

To regard us as having established a communication system subject to your price control escapes our logic. Are you going to control the prices of those who manufacture the equipment? Of those who repair it?

Does this by any chance have a relationship to AT&T's efforts to require all of us to change our systems so that they are compatible with AT&T's? I notice that part of the proposal is that we notify our quests if we are using an alternative operator service (alternative to what?) so that they can request use of another carrier - at no charge.

What is this craziness? What are you guys getting into here? What is the purpose of all of this regulation?
