There are several voice-over-internet-protocol (VoIP) services available, but many of them come at a high cost per user, per month. For small businesses with a larger staff, the cost may be too high to consider. Enable your team to connect with clients and leads with free VoIP phone services.

The apps work on most smartphones, and some include desktop or browser versions. The free plans won't set you back a cent if you keep calls and texts to domestic lines only (United States and Canada). Many VoIP services for phones use ads to keep the apps free to use but usually offer a way for you to pay to remove ads or add-ons to make the app more useful (such as for international calls or voicemail).

Methodology

The most important factor for choosing the best free VoIP phone service provider is finding one that's truly free. We found very few options available that fit all the criteria, so we bent a little on the factors we used to rank these free VoIP phone services. We focused on free plans, plus the affordability of paid plans, unlimited calls or meetings, device compatibility and overall value:

- Free plan: The key factor for all VoIP services we considered is that they offer a truly free way to call others using a smartphone or desktop app.
- Affordable paid plans: Using a free plan usually means having to deal with still or video ads in between calls or banner ads on text message screens. So, we also looked at the cost of paid plans, add-ons or how much a company charges to remove ads.
- Unlimited calls and texts: We considered how each free VoIP phone service limits you and found most allow unlimited calls, texts or video meetings for domestic outbound communication. Most services also offer low international rates for calling or texting outside the U.S. and Canada.
- Device compatibility: Although we consider it best to offer a mobile app for iOS and Android, we didn't knock off too much from the score for having one, but not the other. And we gave credit to those that offer a desktop or browser option because it's helpful to businesses that don't invest in smartphones for employees.
- Overall value: When comparing features, limits, add-ons, paid plans, customer reviews, ease of use and functionality, you get the overall value of a VoIP phone service provider.
