TO ALL PARITES OF RECORD:

On May 28, 2002, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) filed a request for continuance of the dates for filing supplemental direct testimony concerning a proposed PCA from Wednesday, May 29, 2002, until Monday, June 3, 2002. PSE represents that Staff and Public Counsel have agreed to this proposal, subject to the understanding that the current June 24, 2002, deadline for responsive PCA testimony and July 1, 2002, deadline for rebuttal PCA testimony will remain as currently scheduled, to permit sufficient time for hearing preparation if a hearing on the PCA becomes necessary. PSE states that all parties have been informed of the proposed extension and that PSE has heard no objection.

PSE states that the basis for its request is that the parties to this proceeding who are participating in the PCA collaborative settlement discussions have reached a settlement with respect to PCA issues, but are still working on drafting a final document containing settlement terms for execution by the parties.

It does not appear that granting PSE's request would disrupt the procedural schedule insofar as evidentiary hearing and other critical dates are concerned. PSE's request shows that there is good cause to adjust the schedule for filing supplemental testimony.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the deadline for PSE to file supplemental direct testimony concerning a proposed PCA is changed from Wednesday, May 29, 2002, to Monday June 3, 2002. The current June 24, 2002, deadline for responsive PCA testimony and July 1, 2002, deadline for rebuttal PCA testimony will remain as currently scheduled.
