

Resolution No. 209

WHEREAS, Council Order No. 544 required the Washington Public Power Supply System to mitigate the fishery loss occasioned during the testing of the WNP-2 water intake facility; and

WHEREAS, the Supply System was required to fund the construction and operation of hatchery facilities capable of producing 11,100 pounds of fall chinook salmon per year for four years; and

WHEREAS, the required amount of fingerling salmon have been released each year for four years; and


WHEREAS, the Department of Fisheries by letter of July 20, 1982 did express satisfaction with the fish-rearing requirements of Order No. 544;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, That the Council finds and declares that the requirements of Order No. 544 will have been fully satisfied on receipt of evidence of the payment of late charges and the performance of ancillary third party contracts.


