Subject: Wild Horse Wind Power Project Expansion – Issuance of Coverage Under General NPDES Permits for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Construction Activities, and Sand and Gravel General Permit for Concrete Batch Plant Activities.

Dear Ms. Diaz:

Pursuant to its authority under Chapter 80.50 RCW, EFSEC hereby approves coverage of the Wild Horse Project for construction stormwater and concrete batch plant activities under the conditions of these two general permits. Coverage is effective as of March 31, 2009. The Construction Stormwater and Sand and Gravel General Permits that EFSEC issued for the initial project on October 15, 2005 remain in effect. The concrete batch plant permit coverage page is enclosed. We encourage you to review these documents carefully, as the Wild Horse Project must comply with all stated permit conditions.

Compliance monitoring by EFSEC

EFSEC has contracted with Ecology CRO to monitor Project compliance under these two general permits. EFSEC hereby designates Ecology CRO staff to conduct compliance monitoring on EFSEC's behalf of the Wild Horse Project activities under the NPDES Construction Stormwater and Sand and Gravel Permits. For purposes of Rights of Inspection pursuant to SCA Article III.D, Ecology CRO staff, under contract with EFSEC, are to be considered EFSEC's designated representatives. 
