Tariff revisions of the annual commodity adjustment allowing the company to retain up to 50 percent of the revenue from the sale of recyclable commodities and decrease the credit to customers from \$0.77 per month to \$0.47 per month for residential recycling customers, for multi-family recycling customers decreasing the credit from \$0.21 to \$0.04.
