#### 5. TG-210052 Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc.

Request for less-than-statutory notice for tariff revisions that would generate approximately \$94,000 (0.4 percent) additional annual revenue to recover the increased cost of disposal fees set by Pierce County Recycling, Composting & Disposal dba LRI. On March 1, 2020, disposal fees will increase from \$167.38 per ton to \$168.51 per ton at the Pierce County solid waste system facilities. Pierce County Refuse serves approximately 59,600 garbage customers in Pierce County. Also, for customers residing on Joint Base Lewis-McChord (JBLM), the disposal fee will increase from \$112.38 to \$115.47 per ton, which would generate approximately 16,600 (1.2 percent) in additional annual revenue. Pierce County Refuse serves approximately 4,300 customers on JBLM. The company's last general rate increase became effective on May 1, 2020.

Request for less-than-statutory notice for tariff revisions that would generate approximately \$40,390 (0.80 percent) additional annual revenue to recover the increased cost of disposal fees set by Grant, Adams, and Lincoln Counties and the Greater Wenatchee Regional Landfill. On March 1, 2021, disposal fees will increase from \$27.80 per ton to \$47.62 per ton at the Ephrata Landfill in Grant County and from \$79.00 per ton to \$80.00 per ton at Adams County transfer stations and from \$10.72 per ton to \$11.15 per ton at Lincoln County transfer stations and from \$69.12 per ton to \$72.58 per ton at the Greater Wenatchee Regional Landfill. The company serves approximately 18,500 residential and 1,750 commercial garbage customers in Grant County. The company's last general rate increase became effective on March 1, 2012.
