Proposed tariff revision to recover \$350,450 (0.91 percent) of incremental COVID-19 costs over a two-year period beginning August 1, 2021, and ending July 31, 2023. Each tariff rate would be increased by 0.4 percent. The company services approximately 60,500 residential; 1,800 commercial; 2,900 multi-family, 277 roll-off; 60,900 residential recycling; 2,700 multi-family recycling; and 37,000 yard waste customers in Pierce County.
