UW-220218	<p>Great Basin Water Co.</p> <p>General rate increase request that, as initially proposed would have generated approximately \$108,000 (32.1 percent) additional annual revenue for water service. Staff and the Company have agreed to a revised revenue requirement of approximately \$80,000 (23.9 percent) in additional annual revenue. The company is combining the operations of the former Harrison-Ray Water Company, Harrison Water Company-Kiona, LLC, and Sunrise Acres Water Services, LLC water systems into a single tariff, utilizing single tariff rates. The requested increase is due to increases in contracted services, general operating, utility, and wage expenses. The company is also seeking to increase ancillary charges. The company provides regulated water service to approximately 483 customers in Benton and Walla Walla Counties. The most recent rate increases for the former Harrison-Ray Water Company and Harrison Water Company-Kiona systems was in 2008 and 2004, respectively. On June 1, 2022, drop box disposal fees set by Skagit County Public Works at the Skagit County Transfer Station will increase from \$108 to \$110 per ton. The disposal fee includes a \$7 per ton surcharge on refuse from San Juan County. The company uses the Skagit County Transfer Station occasionally, and currently has no affected customers. 6/1/2022 Proposed tariff revision that would generate approximately \$102,826.34 (2.8 percent) additional annual revenue to recover the increased cost of disposal fees set by Kitsap County Board of Commissioners. On June 1, 2022, item 230 disposal fees (MSW) increased from \$90.00 per ton to \$104.00 per ton and an increase to bulky waste from \$120.82 per ton to \$163.11 per ton at the Olympic View Transfer Station. The company serves approximately 7,450 residential, commercial, and drop box garbage customers in Kitsap County. The company's last general rate increase became effective on February 1, 2017.

		6/1/2022	<p>Special Contract for electric distribution service from Avista Corporation to Consolidated Irrigation District No. 19. This agreement replaces a similar agreement that expired September 30, 2021, which remains in effect under the terms of their contract until the Commission approves a replacement agreement. The monthly charge for distribution service under the proposed contract will decrease from \$9,104.64 to \$8,628.18 per month, or \$103,538.18 per year. This change results in a decrease of 0.001 percent in total revenue.</p>
