7. TG-220676 **Zippy Disposal Service, Inc.**

Less than statutory notice request for tariff revisions resulting in a general rate increase in Item 230 disposal fees. On September 19, 2022, disposal fees set by Chelan County Board of Commissioners for the North Chelan Transfer Station will increase from \$23.17 to \$24.15 per non-compacted yard and from \$37.79 to \$39.59 per compacted yard. The Company serves approximately 2,500 customers in Chelan and Douglas Counties. The Company's last general rate increase became effective on June 3, 2019.
