A residential customer using an average of 932 kWhs per month would see an increase of \$2.84 per month, or approximately 3.2 percent on their monthly bill. The Company also proposes a net benefit associated with the Company's Schedule 87, Voluntary Solar Select Program, of \$1,154,955 in 2022. Single family customers may still choose container service, but only at substantially higher pricing for on-call collection charges. Single families who operate businesses on their properties that qualify under Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-70-041 would be able to continue their current service under the commercial rate table. Multi-can service is less per month than container service, customers subject to conversion to can service will see a decrease in their monthly charges. The Company is also requesting to remove service levels 5 yards and above because the larger containers cause damage to equipment and are a safety hazard when full. The Company has approximately 500 commercial customers with container service.
