Customers who cannot demonstrate they are a business, would not qualify for regular container service. Single family customers may still choose container service, but only at substantially higher pricing for on-call collection charges. Single families who operate businesses on their properties that qualify under Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-70-041 would be able to continue their current service under the commercial rate table. Multi-can service is less per month than container service, customers subject to conversion to can service will see a decrease in their monthly charges. The Company is also requesting to remove service levels 5 yards and above because the larger containers cause damage to equipment and are a safety hazard when full. The Company has approximately 500 commercial customers with container service.
